JOB SUMMARY

This position is located in the Operations Division of EMBARK. **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**: Supervisory work that involves dispatching, directing and monitoring of buses and bus operators. This positions is responsible for monitoring bus operators for violations of EMBARK policies, and city and state traffic laws, investigation of accidents involving EMBARK vehicles, incidents and injury cases, responding to street problems or disputes involving EMBARK vehicles, property and/or bus operators and insuring that all necessary employee paperwork is completed and submitted in a timely fashion. Must be capable of operating bus when called upon in emergency situations. Will be required to perform dispatch functions on an as needed basis. Work is performed independently and Manager reviews work product through conferences, staff meetings, reports and observations of work. Required to make on-site, instantaneous decisions affecting the organization.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Skill in communicating verbal and in writing using tact and diplomacy in dealing with subordinates and the general public.
- Ability to successfully complete new and on-going training in the development and proficiency of supervisory skills and new software programs and apply skills learned when performing job duties.
- Skill in evaluating current programs and recommending improvements.
- Ability to effectively plan, organize and direct the work of others.
- Willingness and ability to learn new computer software programs.
- Willingness and ability to learn administer and document appropriate employee counseling and discipline.
- Ability to remain calm and exercise sound judgment when addressing stressful or emergency situations that may arise with employees or the general public.
- Ability to follow complex oral or written instructions.
- Willingness to enforce EMBARK policies and safety regulations.
- Possess a valid Oklahoma Commercial Driver's License (class B) with a Passenger (P) endorsement no later than 30 days from the date of employment.
- Ability to comply with strict attendance policies.
- Ability to maintain confidential information.

Note: Successful applicant will be required to pass a Department of Transportation physical examination that will include a drug screen.

WORKING CONDITIONS
